


#### Pharmacy & Medical Data: Real-World Claims Data Generation

Data flow of a common retail prescription claim








#### **Origins of PBM Industry in Distribution**




#### **RxEOB Sources and Uses of Data**



Stars results are comprised of data from HEDIS, CAHPS, HOS, and administrative data collection

Star ratings are at the payor contract (not plan) level

Each data source requires strict, CMSguided standards when collecting data from providers



CMS Stars Program



#### **How CMS Stars Work**

Each measure has cut points that determine the number of stars awarded for that measure\*

- Different cut points exist for MA vs MA-PDP vs PDP contracts
- There is typically a special cut point at the four star mark (since this is threshold for increased payouts)

#### Each measure is categorized and each category is weighted\*:

- 1x = all new measures and process measures
- 1.5x = patient experience and access measures
- 3x = outcomes and intermediate outcomes measures
- 5x = part C and D quality improvement measures

The weight average star rating, rounded to the nearest half star, is the star rating for the plan\*






